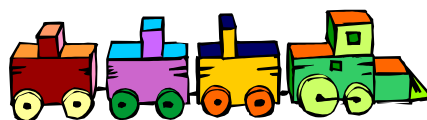

What are Contact Centres?

Child Contact Centres are neutral meeting places where children of separated families can enjoy contact with one (or both) parents, and sometimes other family members, in a comfortable and safe environment when there is no viable alternative.

What do Contact Centres offer?

Contact Centres aim to provide short-term help and support towards establishing meaningful contact between child and visiting parent.

Centres are staffed by volunteers whose role is to make contact an enjoyable experience for both child and parent.

Referrals are made by:

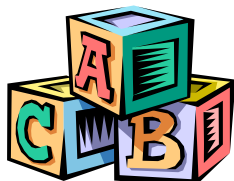
